ABOUT MALAYSIA OPEN SCIENCE PLATFORM (MOSP)

The Malaysia Open Science Platform (MOSP) is a raw research data sharing platform initiated by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI). The pilot initiative is managed by the Academy of Sciences Malaysia (ASM).

This pilot scale starts with 5 research universities, namely Universiti Malaya, Universiti Sains Malaysia, Universiti Putra Malaysia, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia and Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia. Currently, MOSP is also integrated with Open Government Data by Malaysian Administrative Modernisation and Management Planning Unit (MAMPU) and Raw Data for Research and Sciences (RADARS), MOSTI.

The MOSP initiative focuses on 3 aspects:



MALAYSIA OPEN SCIENCE ALLIANCE (MOSA)

The Malaysia Open Science Alliance (MOSA) was formed to foster cooperation and trust between main stakeholders of open science. The Alliance aims to support open science practices to facilitate enhanced research ecosystem for an accelerated problem-solving and open innovation.



1. Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation – Malaysian Science and Technology Information Center (MASTIC)

- Facilitate national STI initiative as a reference centre for strategic Science, Technology & Innovation (STI) Information.



2. Academy of Sciences Malaysia (ASM)

- Strive to be the Nation's Thought Leader for matters related to science, technology, innovation and economy.



3. Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE)

- Strengthen the digital ecosystem of higher education towards knowledge sharing and empowering research, development, innovation, and commercialisation.



4. Ministry of Natural Resources, Environment and Climate Change (NRECC)

- Move towards an integrated natural resources governance through the empowerment of expertise, information sharing, and technology in research.



5. Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH)

- Leverage analytics and data intelligence in policy planning and development to drive the delivery of health services.
